FAMILY FIRST PREVENTION SERVICES ACT

Two major components of the new law

1. Prevention Services:

New <u>optional program</u> for states and tribes to get federal funds to help <u>prevent</u> placing children in foster care

2. Improve the Quality of Foster Care:

For those children who cannot remain safely at home, there are new federal policies to ensure appropriate placements; if a state does not comply, it will have to use pure state/local dollars to pay for certain kinds of foster care

Without regard to income, families can have access to these federally reimbursed services for up to 12 months with no limit on how many times
